## **1. On the Progress of Work on the Internationalization of Higher Education and Academic Mobility: Results and Plans**

### **Resolution:**

1. To strengthen efforts aimed at increasing student participation in external academic mobility programs. *Deadline: January-June 2026. Responsible: heads of the departments of geography, chemistry, physics, informatics, russian language and literature, foreign languages and translation studies, kazakh language and literature, vocational training and fine arts, music education, preschool education and training, pedagogy, psychology, theory and methods of physical education, academic mobility office.*

2. To increase the level of participation of the academic staff in external academic mobility programs. *deadline: February-november 2026. responsible: heads of the departments of mathematics, physics, informatics, biology, russian language and literature, foreign languages and translation studies, kazakh language and literature, english language, music education, primary education methodology, pedagogy, theory and methods of physical education, academic mobility office.*

3. To intensify efforts to strengthen cooperation with the University's strategic partners and to implement joint and double-degree educational programs. *Deadline: february-april 2026. responsible: international cooperation and monitoring office, international programs office, institute of postgraduate education, deans of faculties, heads of departments.*

4. To carry out work aimed at increasing the proportion of academic staff delivering instruction in English within the total academic staff of the University. *Deadline: august 2026. Responsible: heads of departments.*

5. To ensure responsible implementation of measures aimed at increasing participation in international grant-funded projects. *deadline: january-june 2026. responsible: heads of departments, international programs office.*

6. To take measures to increase the involvement of foreign experts and visiting academic staff in teaching activities. *deadline: january-june 2026. responsible: academic mobility office, heads of departments.*

7. To systematically implement measures aimed at increasing the number of international students (applicants), including expanding outreach to both near and far abroad within career guidance activities. *deadline: january-august 2026. responsible: deans of faculties, heads of departments, marketing office.*

8. To carry out work aimed at increasing the share of educational programs included in top subject rankings among the total number of the University's

educational programs. *deadline: january-august 2026. responsible: heads of departments.*

9. To implement measures aimed at increasing the share of educational programs included in the TOP-10 of national subject rankings. *deadline: january-august 2026. responsible: heads of departments.*

10. Control over the implementation of this resolution shall be assigned to the Vice-Rectors in charge.

## **2. On the Progress of the Implementation of the Strategic Development Plan for Educational, Research, and Upbringing Activities of the Faculty of Natural Sciences**

### **Resolution:**

1. To carry out work aimed at increasing both the number and quality of Massive Open Online Courses (MOOCs). *deadline: 2026. responsible: heads of departments.*

2. To strengthen the implementation of measures aimed at increasing the employment rate of graduates. *deadline: ongoing. responsible: dean of the faculty, heads of departments, “talant upgrade” center.*

3. To enhance the participation of academic staff and students in external academic mobility programs. *deadline: 2026. responsible: academic mobility office, deans of faculties, heads of departments.*

4. To intensify efforts to invite foreign experts and visiting professors within the framework of external academic mobility programs. *deadline: 2026. responsible: academic mobility office, deans of faculties, heads of departments.*

5. To carry out work on the implementation of international research projects and double-degree educational programs with universities ranked in the TOP-700 of the QS ranking. *Deadline: 2026-2027 academic year. responsible: heads of departments, international programs office.*

6. In order to enhance the research capacity of the Department of Geography, to ensure the recruitment of academic staff holding advanced academic degrees. *Deadline: 2026. Responsible: Head of the Department.*

7. To update the format of cooperation with department branches and partner (base) schools, and to develop and implement relevant methodological guidelines. *deadline: 2026. responsible: dean of the faculty, heads of departments, “talant upgrade” center.*

8. To take measures aimed at increasing the share of educational programs of the Department of Chemistry included in the TOP-10 national subject rankings. *deadline: january-august 2026. responsible: heads of departments.*

9. Control over the implementation of this resolution shall be assigned to the Vice-Rectors in charge.
